Financial Reports and Approvals

The Business Director reviewed bank balances and presented claims to the Board highlighting significant items, among them: New York City water bills, final payment for Capital project A-1310 new transmission main (Barry Ave / Macy Rd), payroll costs, engineering costs related to various projects,

monthly NYSHIP premium, meter setting and valve purchases, City of New Rochelle infrastructure related taxes and costs related to a temporary pump needed for the Purchase Booster Station.

Approval of Claims: Trustee Belmont made a motion to approve 175 claims totaling \$2,373,556.68 – removing from consideration for approval, the final claim payment to ELQ in the amount of \$358,745.32 pending resolution of pavement issues along Avondale Road, potentially related to work done as part of Capital project A-1310 at Barry Ave/Macy Rd. Trustee Murphy seconded the motion, all in favor:

General Administration:

• The Business Director reported that a WJWW vehicle was re-auctioned online. The result was that the 2001 Ford F250, which is inoperable, received a high bid of \$1,050.00 (\$300 over the first auction result). Trustee Murphy made a motion to approve the auction result as presented. Trustee Belmont seconded the motion, all in favor:

Rye Lake Filtration Facility: General Counsel reminded the Board that an initial draft of a Co-Lead Agency agreement was sent, attorney to attorney, to the TVOH Planning Board on July 27th. The Planning Consultant for the Planning Board was also copied on this draft. Counsel also reminded the Board that the Filtration Facility, a Committee Report item, was taken off of the Planning Board's September 22nd meeting agenda the morning of the meeting and that the Planning Board submitted additional questions, as to potential segmentation with this project and the current proposal up for approval of the UV Facility at the Rye Lake source. WJWW responded with a comprehensive submission answering the questions and provided factual basis for the argument that there would be no segmentation, as these are two independent projects. The submission was made a full 21 days before their scheduled October 27th meeting, as required by the Planning Board, and in order to give the Board members sufficient time to review the document. Counsel was informed that once the submission was made, the Planning Board would make a determination and move forward on both matters. The projects have now been placed back on the Planning Board's agenda and Counsel is hopeful that they will discuss the Co-Lead Agency relationship for the Rye Lake Filtration Facility and perhaps recommend a resolution be made to circulate a Notice of Intent to act as Co-Lead agents with WJWW. Counsel is also optimistic that she will have news indicating ongoing communications and progress for this project at the next BOT meeting.

The Business Director presented to the Board, a revised proposal from Co-Communications to provide public relations services for WJWW's five-year plan in the not-to-exceed amount of \$51,000.00. Trustee Murphy made a motion to approve the proposal and Trustee Belmont seconded the motion, all in favor:

• UV Treatment Facility: Subsequently and on a parallel track, this facility is listed as an Action Item on the TVOH Planning Board's October 27th meeting agenda and representatives from H2M will be in attendance to address any questions that the Board may have related to this separate project.

Old Business

The General Superintendent explained that Distribution staff replaced 5 hydrants as well as 6 service lines and responded to 131 service calls over the last 10 days, which included meter backflow inspections and final meter readings, as examples. He also gave an update on the following project:

• 60 Halstead Avenue / TVOH: Work related to this project has been delayed because of on-going hydrant flushing in the area, but is expected to begin the morning of October 15th. The Manager added that flushing work, that was cancelled in March due to the COVID-19 pandemic, is taking longer than usual because of rigorous measures that have been implemented to protect against any accumulation of biofilm organisms in the lines. The Manager explained that the extra measures will effectively scour the entire WJWW system and remove any build up.

The Chief Water Treatment Plant Operator reported that the Operations staff have taken approximately 167 routine bacteriological water samples in the past ten days. This sampling includes raw water, high turbidity, calcium, phosphate and total organic carbon (TOC) testing. He also gave an update on the following project:

• Winged Foot Tank Rehabilitation / TOM: The Chief Water Treatment Plant Operator explained that this job has been completed and that the tank has been filled with water. Following initial water sample testing which yielded favorable results, WJWW is currently awaiting a second set of test results to come in. Once WCDOH gives approval, the tank will be put back in service.

• Mamaroneck Avenue Bridge (TVOH / VOM): The Business Director explained that Westchester County is rehabilitating the bridge along Mamaroneck Avenue near the entrance to I-95 in the TVOH and WJWW has agreed to cover the cost of the inspection and testing of the water main that will be replaced as a result of this work. Approval of the Engineering and Design Services proposal related to the replacement of 190 linear feet of water main, in the estimated, not-to-exceed amount of \$22,454.00 (Wasp Engineering), was requested. Trustee Belmont made a motion to approve the Engineering and Design Services proposal. Trustee Seligson seconded the motion, all in favor:

Thus, by representing WJWW, the Firm will not be serving as counsel to the Village of Mamaroneck, Town of Mamaroneck and the Town/Village of Harrison. Nor will the Firm be acting as counsel for WJWW's trustees, directors, officers or employees.

We cannot guarantee any particular legal result, but we assure you that we will work vigorously and efficiently. The quality of our work is paramount, and while we do not sacrifice quality to economy, we do recognize the need for cost effective representation. In all client matters we attempt to utilize those lawyers and legal assistants having the lowest hourly billing rates that are commensurate with the degree of specialization and level of experience required in order to achieve your objective. The selection of those lawyers and legal assistants who will render services to you will be made by me as the lawyer having overall supervisory responsibility for your matter, taking into consideration the nature of the work, the office in which most of those services are likely to be rendered, the degree of legal experience, knowledge and specialization required in order to achieve your objective, the availability of lawyers and legal assistants to work on your matter and their hourly billing rates.

We take into account many factors in billing for services rendered. The principal factor is usually our time costs billed at our hourly rates for the attorneys and legal assistants who do the work. However, because WJWW is a non-profit public benefit corporation, BCLP will reduce its rates by ten percent for this engagement. Thus, for this engagement, my hourly rate will be \$774 (not \$860). For the purpose of this engagement, the 2020 rates of our attorneys and other time-keepers will be "frozen" for 2021 and 2022. WJWW will not be charged for travel time attending board meetings (or other meetings). We also encourage you to inquire about any matters relating to our fee arrangements or monthly statements that are in any way unclear.

1 Our Team

- 1.1 You may contact your client relationship lawyer at any time to discuss any aspect of our services.

10 Anti-Money Laundering

- 10.1 In certain jurisdictions where the BCLP Firm operates, we are obliged to obtain and hold satisfactory evidence of the identity of our clients and sometimes of related people to comply with anti-money laundering ("AML") and anti-terrorist financing legislation.
- 10.2 We take a risk-based and proportionate approach to identifying clients for AML purposes. Sometimes we may need to: see original documents; check the information you provide; use corporate, personal and/or confidential information to check identity through electronic data sources; and ask you for up-to-date evidence of identity.

- 10.6 If we are unable to satisfy ourselves as to source of funds, monies paid to us will usually be frozen and not applied to the transaction, unless and until the appropriate authorities consent.
- 10.7 We will not make payments to anyone other than you unless this is a necessary part of the transaction, and then only if you instruct us to do so.

11 Termination of Engagement

11.1 You may terminate our engagement with or without cause at any time on written notice to us. Termination of our services will not affect your responsibility to pay for legal services rendered and all expenses and other charges incurred up to the date when we receive notice of termination, and for any further work required of us in order to facilitate an orderly turnover of matters in process at the time of termination.

- 11.2 We may terminate our engagement for any of the reasons permitted under the New York Rules of Professional Conduct, including your deliberate disregard to pay fees, insistence upon conduct contrary to our judgment and advice, insistence upon presenting a claim or defense that is not warranted under existing law and cannot be supported by good faith argument, or any other conduct that renders it unreasonably difficult for us to carry out employment effectively or presents conflicts with our professional responsibilities. - 11.3 Our attorney-client relationship will also terminate when a matter for which our Firm was hired has been completed, whether or not our bill to you for services has been rendered or paid. Upon termination of our relationship, the Firm has no duty to accept new engagements or to continue representation in any matters unless mutually agreed in writing.
- 11.4 Once a matter ends, we will not remind you about future time deadlines or obligations relevant to that matter unless we expressly agree to do so in writing.

12 Future Representation

12.1 In the event our engagement necessitates that we prepare an agreement which provides for ongoing rights and obligations on your part, a dispute concerning the interpretation or enforceability of that agreement may subsequently arise after our engagement has been terminated. In the absence of our express written agreement, you may not assume that the Firm will continue to be free to represent you in a future dispute concerning such agreement.

13 Retention of Files

- 14.2 In the event that a dispute arises between us concerning the services we have provided to you, whether claims for legal malpractice, breach of fiduciary duty, breach of contract, or any other claim based upon alleged attorney misconduct, or a fee dispute to which Part 137 does not apply, then that dispute will be settled by arbitration

before an arbitral forum other than that prescribed by Part 137. Such an arbitration shall be heard in the City of New York by a panel of three arbitrators, all of whom must be attorneys practicing in that City, with one arbitrator to be selected by each party and the third to be chosen by the two arbitrators or the parties to the arbitration. The arbitrators may establish such rules for the conduct of the arbitration as they may choose, except that those rules shall be consistent with the procedural rules of the American Arbitration Association for commercial arbitrations: the arbitrators shall have the power to award all relief available in a court of law; and the arbitration proceedings shall be private and confidential and shall not be disclosed to the public by either the arbitrators or the parties to the arbitration. The award of the arbitrators must be by a majority vote and shall be final and binding, not subject to challenge by either party in any court of law. The arbitrators shall determine which party shall pay for the arbitrators' fees and the costs of the proceedings, but in any event each party shall bear its own costs of legal representation, if any, in the proceeding. Although you can consult another lawyer with respect to this provision, we believe that it is desirable because, although both parties give up the right to a jury trial, to full discovery, and to appellate review, arbitration generally is a quicker and less expensive method of dispute resolution and the privacy of the process can be assured.

15 Charges

- 15.1 Our statements to our clients are normally rendered on a monthly basis, and ordinarily include certain charges other than fees for legal services. These charges may include third-party expenses (such as filing fees, court reporters and travel) and internal expenses. Under some circumstances, clients may be asked to contract with and pay directly larger third-party invoices. Other third-party expenses will be added to our bills with no markup. The Firm has elected to charge for certain support activities on the basis of each client's individual use instead of covering them in its hourly rates for fee earners. The internal charges will be billed in the following way:
- 15.2 Mail: There is no charge for regular mail. Clients are charged the actual cost of express mail and bulk mailings, as well as air express couriers.
- 15.3 Messengers: Clients are charged the actual costs of outside messenger service. In some instances, Firm personnel may be used in lieu of an outside messenger service to reduce delivery time. In those cases, delivery charges are competitive with those of the outside messenger.
- 15.4 **Reprographics Costs**: The Firm charges \$.20 per page for black and white images (including copies, prints and scans), \$.70 per page for color images. When required by size or time constraints of the specific

- project, reprographics services may be provided by outside vendors and will be charged to clients at actual cost.
- 15.5 **Binding**: The Firm charges \$5.00 for each binding (velo, spiral, fastback, etc.) job.
- 15.6 **Data Transfers**: The Firm charges a fixed rate for burning CDs and DVDs at \$8 and \$12, respectively.
- 15.7 Computer Research: The Firm uses several databases to conduct computer-assisted research. The Firm contracts for the majority of those database services in bulk and for several years in advance. The Firm bills clients at a discount from the vendors' regular rates to third parties where applicable. Charges for usage of databases that are not included under these advance contracts, and all other research databases, are billed to clients at actual cost.
- 15.8 **Long-Distance Telephone Calls**: The Firm does not charge clients for long-distance telephone calls.

16 Applicable Law

16.1 Even though our Firm has offices and transacts business in numerous locations, our attorney-client relationship will be governed by New York law, including the New York Rules of Professional Conduct.
