Financial Reports and Approvals

David Birdsall, Business Director, reviewed bank balances and presented claims to the Board highlighting significant items, among them: Partial Distribution of 2020 WJWW Income to Members, Rye Lake UV Facility Project (Engineered Fluid- Pre-Fab Building & Filingeri Electric), Payroll Costs, Water Distribution System Repairs and Water Main Projects (Etre Associates), NYSHIP Premiums (September & October), Purchase Booster Station Project (All Makes Pumps, Etre & Xylem), and SCADA System Upgrades and Operations Assistance (Woodard & Curran).

Approval of Claims: Trustee Belmont made a motion to approve 228 claims totaling \$2,553,850.00. Trustee Murphy seconded the motion, all in favor:

General Administration:

• Rehabilitation of Purchase Street Tanks (Joint Capital Projects): Project approval for the rehabilitation of the Purchase Street Tank #1 (A-1375) and the Purchase Street Tank #2 (A-1382), which are part of the WJWW 5-Year Capital Improvement Plan, was presented to the Board for

consideration. Routine inspections have noted multiple failures of the coating system on these two 1.0-million gallon water storage ground tanks. The rehabilitation work involves the removal of deteriorated coating from the tanks' interior and exterior surfaces, the application of new coatings to properly protect the structural steel and additional improvements to ensure the tanks meet current regulatory requirements. The total estimated cost for the rehabilitation of both tanks is \$3,300,000 (\$1,650,000 per tank), with construction expected to take place in 2022. Trustee Murphy made a motion to approve the joint capital projects to rehabilitate Purchase Street Tank #1 (A-1375) and the Purchase Street Tank #2 (A-1382), separate from Engineering and professional service costs. - Shaft 22 Crisfield Pumping Station Chlorination Project (Joint Capital Project): Frank Arcara, General Superintendent, explained that the WJWW project related to the installation of a Tablet Chlorination System at the Crisfield Pumping Station, in the City of Yonkers, is necessary because by year end NYCDEP will no longer be chlorinating at this site. Although WJWW currently performs chlorination at the nearby WJWW Weaver Street facility, it is not enough to simply increase chlorination there. Contact time limitations and the need to meet proper target residuals, dictates that WJWW look to next options. WJWW had a presence in the past at the Crisfield Pumping Station (housing chemicals there), so this makes for a favorable partnership for WJWW and the City of Yonkers. Discussions with WJWW staff, WJWW's General Counsel and Representatives from the City of Yonkers are continuing. It was decided that this project will be presented for Board approval once an updated cost estimate is determined and an agreed upon Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is established between all parties.
- Rye Lake Filtration Plant: Lori Lee Dickson, General Counsel, reported that WJWW consultants are continuing their work on tasks related to the DEIS, including finalizing the site plan and meeting with fire safety inspectors to address any items related to TVOH codes. The updated DEIS Scope is expected to be presented for Board approval sometime in October. WJWW staff members and consultants continue to meet weekly to ensure that a complete and thorough review is being conducted of all matters related to this project, as well as to ensure that the final documents reflect comments from the public and from agencies who participated in the draft of the Scope.

Lori Lee Dickson, General Counsel, also took the opportunity to explain to the public that the WJWW BOT meetings are generally business meetings to report on operational aspects that the Board needs to consider and vote on. WJWW staff, including WJWW in-house engineers, attend in order to answer any questions that may arise related to project design. The public will be given the opportunity to make comments during the SEQR process for the upcoming Filtration Plant, in accordance with all requirements and were reminded that if they would like to make any comments at this time, they should access the Filtration Plant microsite at wjwwfiltration.com.

Old Business

Manager's Report

Paul Kutzy, Manager, explained that Frank Arcara, General Superintendent, would report to the Board on the WJWW preparation and response to the severe storm that recently hit the area. In anticipation of the arrival of the remnants of Hurricane Ida, on Wednesday, September 1st, Frank Arcara, General Superintendent, assigned additional staff to various WJWW facilities. He shared that at approximately 11:45 p.m., he received a call that the WJWW garage was starting to flood and directed staff to relocate dispatch vehicles to higher ground. Unfortunately, the waters rose at such a rate that one locked vehicle was unable to be moved in time and sustained damage from the flood. During the overnight hours, power was lost at Rye Lake, but emergency generators provided backup as expected. Power was not lost at any other WJWW facility. On the morning of Thursday, September 2nd, water, which had ultimately risen to about one foot deep in the WJWW garage, had receded. A few PRV vaults (North Barry, for example) sustained some minor flooding, but were pumped out was successfully. The pipes in these vaults are coated in an epoxy, so no damage was done. WJWW staff reached out to the three member municipalities to offer support by way of staff or materials in the aftermath of the storm. WJWW was able to provide assistance to the TOM with material that was stockpiled. The Trustees all thanked Paul Kutzy, Manager, and the WJWW staff for their offer of assistance. David Birdsall, Business Director, shared that insurance companies will be assessing the damage to the flooded WJWW vehicle, the garage floor, as well as, a couple of generators, pumps and some welding equipment that were lost due to the flood waters. WJWW will reach out to FEMA to see if there is the potential for some financial assistance through that agency.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This non-binding Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU") dated _______, 2021, by and between the County of Westchester, a municipal corporation of the State of New York, Michaelian Office Building, 148 Martine Avenue, White Plains, NY 10601 (the "County") and the Westchester Joint Water Works, 1625 Mamaroneck Avenue, Mamaroneck, NY 10543, a Public Benefit Corporation of the State of New York consisting of three member municipalities of the Town/Village of Harrison, the Village of Mamaroneck and the Town of Mamaroneck (the "WJWW", the County and WJWW, each a "Party," are referred to collectively as the "Parties").

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to record their understandings in relation to a proposed joint undertaking by the drafting and execution of this MOU; and

WHEREAS, the Parties acknowledge that this MOU is a statement of intent as to the proposed Undertaking (defined herein), does not create enforceable rights or obligations, and does not create a binding agreement; and

WHEREAS, this MOU sets out the basic terms upon which the Parties propose, subject to review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") and all other applicable laws and regulations, to enter into a binding agreement ("Formal Agreement") with each other to finalize the Undertaking; and

WHEREAS, only a Formal Agreement, if duly executed and delivered by the Parties, will be enforceable, and such Formal Agreement would supersede the provisions of this MOU and all other agreements and understandings between the Parties with respect to the Undertaking which is the subject matter of this MOU; and

WHEREAS, the terms of this MOU are not intended to be comprehensive and additional terms, including further clarification of areas of responsibility, resources to be committed and reasonable warranties and representations, would be incorporated into such Formal Agreement.

1. BACKGROUND, PURPOSE AND SCOPE:

On November 26, 2019, the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") issued an Administrative Order (SDWA-02-2020-8001) which, in addition to a previously ordered Corrective Action Plan, included an obligation for WJWW to commence design of a filtration plant to treat the surface water drawn from WJWW's Rye Lake water source, a part of the New York City Kensico Reservoir system. To comply with the EPA Administrative Order, comply with all standards for clean drinking water and maintain the health and safety of its water consumers, WJWW has proposed to construct and operate a 30-MGD Dissolved Air Flotation/Filtration (DAFF) water filtration facility (the "Project"). The proposed location for the Project has been identified as an undeveloped 13.4 acre portion of property located on the east side of Purchase Street currently owned by Westchester County, managed by the Westchester County Airport and situated just west of existing airport facilities and aviation operations.

To facilitate the proposed Project, the Parties have proposed to an exchange in fee title of equal sized and valued parcels of property that would result in no net loss of airport property. The 13.4 acre Project parcel would be apportioned from the County Airport property (the "Project Parcel") and deeded to WJWW in exchange for a 13.4 acre parcel owned by WJWW (the "Exchange Parcel") to be deeded to the County and incorporated into the airport property (the "Undertaking").

2. <u>MUTUAL UNDERSTANDINGS</u>:

- A. The Parties agree to work together and co-operate in good faith and to fully participate in efforts to conclude a proposed Formal Agreement that could be executed by the Parties if approved by both Parties after the completion of all required SEORA and other applicable processes.
- B. This MOU in no way restricts the ability of either Party to enter into any agreement with any other third party in relation to either the proposed Project or any other proposed project of a similar nature.
- C. The understandings outlined in this MOU shall subsist until such time as the Formal Agreement is completed or either Party gives the other Party written notice that the Party is withdrawing from the MOU.

D The Parties agree to work together in good faith in order to ensure the preparation of the Formal Agreement and all other preliminary steps that would be required for either Party to commit to the Undertaking and realization of the proposed Project, including the tasks included in Schedule A attached to and incorporated into this MOU, if such Project is approved after the completion of all required SEQRA and other applicable processes. The Parties acknowledge that the Formal Agreement will be contingent on FAA approval, completion of SEQRA review and other applicable processes, and all legal authorizations.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- A. <u>Term and Renewal</u>. The term of this MOU shall commence upon execution by the Parties and extend for one calendar year. The Term hereof may be extended for one or more subsequent terms of one year or less upon agreement of the Parties with the dates of any such Term set forth in a written addendum labeled as such and executed by the Parties.
- B. <u>Contact and Notice</u>. All notices of any nature referred to in this MOU shall be in writing and either sent by registered or certified mail, postage pre-paid, or delivered by hand or overnight courier (with acknowledgment received and a copy of the notice sent by registered or certified mail, postage pre-paid), to the addresses forth below or to such addresses as the Parties may designate in writing. Notice shall be effective on the date of receipt.

- C. Entire Agreement. The provisions herein contained constitute the entire understanding between the parties with respect to the subject matter of the MOU and supersede previous communication, representations, expectations, understandings and agreements whether verbal or written between the parties or their respective representatives with respect to the subject matter of this MOU and shall not be modified or amended except in writing signed by the parties.
- D. <u>Assignment</u>. Neither party may assign or transfer the responsibilities or agreement made herein without the prior written consent of the non-assigning party, which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- E. Governing Law. The provisions of this MOU shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of New York. In addition, the Parties hereby agree that any cause of action arising out of this MOU will be brought in the County of Westchester.
- F. <u>Execution</u>. The signatories to this MOU are fully authorized or have obtained appropriate authorizations by the Parties hereto. This MOU may be executed simultaneously in several identical copies, each of which will be an original and all of which will constitute but one and the same document.
- G. <u>Third Parties</u>. Nothing herein is intended or will be construed to confer upon or give to any third party or its successors and assigns any rights, remedies or basis for reliance upon, under or by reason of this MOU, except in the event that specific third party rights are expressly granted herein.

SCHEDULE "A"

- Deed/transfer rights in WJWW-owned 13.4-acre Exchange Parcel to the County of Westchester for incorporation/merger into the airport property.
- Conduct SEQRA review; WJWW, lead agency and project sponsor, has determined that the Project may potentially result in significant adverse environmental impacts and has directed preparation of an EIS.
- Design Project and acquire approvals from NYS and WC DOH.
- Conduct field work or provide data as needed for wetlands delineation or confirmation.
- Conduct field work at Project Site and Exchange Parcel as may be necessary to calculate metes & bounds for Legal Descriptions to be included in Formal Agreement and any subsequent transactional documents, including easements related to the Project
- Provide County with Environmental Site Assessment data as needed.
- Design and construct portion of sanitary sewer infrastructure on Project Site up to boundary of
 property to be retained by County. Reimburse County for 100% expense of design and
 construction of sanitary sewer infrastructure on County-owned Airport Property which will
 connect Project Site infrastructure with existing infrastructure. Reimburse County for expense
 associated with changes to existing infrastructure necessitated by Project-specific requirements.

COUNTY

- Apportion and Deed to WJWW the 13.4-acre Project Site from larger County-owned Airport
 Property and administratively assign new lot designation as may be required for purposes of
 assessment and zoning in the Town/Village of Harrison.
- Conduct title search for Project Site and any easement areas on County-owned Airport Property and provide results to WJWW.
- Assume lead role in coordination with FAA for all reviews/approvals.
- Provide information as to proposed use of Exchange Parcel for EIS analysis/inclusion.
- Undertake all actions necessary to revise airport layout plan to reflect property exchange.
- Provide authorizations to WJWW as necessary for Project permits or approvals.
- Deed sanitary sewer easement on County-owned Airport Property to WJWW.
- Design and construct the portion of Project sanitary sewer infrastructure that will be located on County-owned Airport Property to connect infrastructure on Project Site with existing infrastructure on County-owned Airport Property.
- Design and complete any required changes to existing sewer infrastructure on County-owned Airport Property.
