Board of Trustees Meeting Tuesday, February 11, 2014 at 4:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 4:08 p.m. with the following present:

Water Bill Inquiry

Inquiry regarding water bill: Mrs. Farly inquired about the amount of her recent water bill and wanted to know why it had gone up. The Manager explained that the consumption history for her account would be reviewed but generally the amount of a bill is affected by two factors: water rates and consumption. He explained that water rates go up every year and consumption varies seasonally and day-to-day based on household and occupants and activities. It was agreed that Mrs. Farly would meet with the WJWW Business Manager soon to go review the account history.

Operations Status Reports

The Manager reported the following regarding various WJWW operations:

a. The 2013 water production through the end of December 2013 was down approximately 1% compared to the end of December 2012.

b. Water Main repairs:

- VOM:
 - Repaired 12" water main break on Carroll Av.
 - Replaced leaking service line on Meadow St.
 - Replaced leaking service line on Oak Ln.
- TOM:
 - Repaired 6" water main leak on Beresford Rd.
 - Severed leaking service line on Boston Post Rd.
- TOH:
 - Replaced 3 broken 6" water main valves and tee on Justin Rd.
 - Replaced broken 8" water main valve on Pleasant Ridge Rd.
 - Replaced 3 broken 8" water main valves and tee on Woodlands Rd.
 - Repaired 8" water main break on Westerleigh Rd.
 - Severed leaking service line on Crotona Av.
 - Repaired 8" water main break on Century Trail.
 - Repaired 12" water main break on Halstead Av. (Replacement of broken valves and road restoration to follow).

c. Storage Tank Rehabilitation/Repairs:

- Repairs have been completed on the 5 tanks (Purchase #1, Purchase #2, Kenilworth, Winged Foot, Park Lane #2) and tanks are back in service.
- Park Lane #1: the low bidder has been notified and contract documents are being prepared.
- Woodside Tank: WJWW's engineer, GHD, is finalizing items needed to obtain WCDOH approvals for full rehab.

d. Meter Reading and Billing Status

- Meter reading for VOM (4,000 +/- accounts) began first week of February.
- Billing expected to begin approximately February 14th.
- e. Status of Evaluation of Non-Member Municipality Customers:
 - The Manager and Business Director gave a status update. WJWW has submitted some of the requested information to UWNR and is currently gathering the remaining information to be submitted.

- f. Upgrade of WJWW Security Monitoring and Access System:
 - WJWW needs to upgrade the existing monitoring and access control at all facilities. WJWW
 received a proposal from a vendor on the state's preapproved list. After review, Trustee
 Rosenblum made a motion to award the proposal to Tyco Integrated Security. Trustee Belmont
 seconded the motion, all in favor:

County UV Alternative Status

WJWW and its engineers are currently reviewing D&B's December 2008/June 2009 proposal to get 100% of WJWW water from the Delaware Aqueduct Shaft 22 and possibly other shafts within NYCDEP's system.

The Manager reported that WJWW is finalizing comments on Westchester County's recent submittal of hydraulic analysis of taking additional water from Shaft 22. The Manager and engineers met with NYCDEP to discuss various options for an alternative water source to Rye Lake.
